Dear Clients and Partners,

First, I would like to inform you of the current logistical developments that may slightly affect the transit of goods through the Poland-Ukraine border. Recent protests by Polish truckers have led to disruptions at the Yagodin and Hrebenne-Rava-Ruska border points. Although the protests have slowed down traffic, they have not led to a complete cessation of movement.

Foreseeing these events, our logistics team has redirected freight to alternative border crossings, specifically Krakovets and Shehyni, to mitigate any significant delays.

The resultant impact on our operations has been minimal, with a 2-7 days of delay in delivery potentially affecting two of our clients. Considering these developments, we have adjusted our delivery schedules to include an additional 10-day buffer to ensure we manage expectations realistically.

We have been assured by our transport partners that they anticipate a resolution to these protests within the coming month.

Regarding current situation with operations - our production continues uninterrupted, with all resources including billets, energy, and water being readily available. Our team remains focused and driven to maintain the high standards of service you expect from us.

Your understanding is greatly appreciated during this time, and we remain at your disposal for any questions you might have.
