## **Ensuring Uninterrupted Production following the Dam Incident**

Dear valued clients and partners,  
I hope this letter finds you well.

I do feel your concerns regarding the recent dam explosion and by this letter I'd like to assure you that the incident has not affected our production operations at Centravis in any way.

For the clearest explanation, below I attach the map that shows that our plant is located above and upstream from the dam, and therefore the water level in the Dnipro River in the Nikopol region decreases.

All that ensures the absolute safety of our employees, their families, and the overall operation, as well as zero impact on the stable supply of utilities at our plant.

In terms of logistics, no additional steps need to be taken, as the roads to the West are dry, ensuring uninterrupted transportation routes.

During the last hour, while I was writing this letter, our press has made 5 tons of pipes; 3 cars 20 tons of finished goods each are being prepared to be dispatched tomorrow morning, and over the next two days, some of our German and Italian clients will have a regular 3.2 inspection by a TUV inspector.
